OUR ADJUDICATOR – HELEN LITTLE



Helen has been teaching music for longer than she cares to remember. She has taught all levels of music from beginners through to tertiary level and is always thrilled to see the development and progress of individuals over time. Helen has also been involved with developing and co-ordinating a variety of festivals and eisteddfods from the National Eisteddfod in Canberra to a music festival in Malaysia, and currently the International Virtual Festival. Helen has worked at Somerset College on the Gold Coast, where she was involved as an instrumental teacher and still coordinates the

Somerset Festival for Young Performers. She spends time each year adjudicating, examining, composing, and providing workshops both in Australia and overseas, Helen has also conducted a choir for the Advent festival in Vienna, and a concert band for the International Band Festival in Tiawan. Helen was asked to conduct the first Australian examinations in Vietnam and last year the first Australian music exams for Thailand as well as exams in Malaysia and Singapore. Helen is the chief examiner for the Australian Guild of Music and Speech. Helen has a strong belief in the importance of music in every person's life and believes that every person should have the opportunity to explore music making as part of their education. As a teacher and examiner her philosophy is "by believing all your geese are swans, you tend to end up with far more swans than you thought possible."


